From Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport to the DoubleTree Resort:

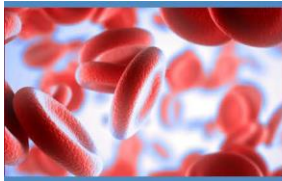
Poster Removal and Collection

With the exception of the Pocket Agenda found in your lanyard/name badge, HTRS will not be printing paper handouts or meeting materials for this conference. Instead, we are going digital with the introduction of the HTRS 2017 Mobile App!

Download the HTRS 2017 Mobile App (the “App”) to your electronic devices by visiting the Apple App Store or Google Play and searching for HTRS 2017. (You can also access real-time event information via your web browser at: [https://htrs2017.zerista.com/.](https://htrs2017.zerista.com/))

Once the App has loaded, you will be asked to enter a username and password.

- Enter the **same email address** you used to register for the conference as your username.
- Enter the default password: **htrs2017** (case sensitive)
- Please be sure to **reset your password** once you are logged in.

Using the App, you will be able to:

- Personalize your own Meeting Schedule
- Stay informed via live social media feeds
- Receive broadcast messages from HTRS to all conference attendees
- Contact other attendees who have registered to use the App, directly through the App. (Please note, this messaging function is only available to registered conference attendees. Individuals not attending the conference will not be able to contact you through the App, nor will you be able to message individuals outside of the conference.)
- If you are using the web-based platform of the App, you can change your privacy settings under the “Settings” tab.

How to Apply for Continuing Education Credits

Before you can apply for CME credits for physicians, nursing credit hours, or contact hours for pharmacists, you must complete and submit an online Evaluation Form. A link to the Evaluation Form will be emailed to you after 12:30 p.m. on Saturday, April 8, 2017, when the conference closes.

Once you complete and submit your online Evaluation Form, you will be given immediate access to a Certificate of Attendance. The Certificate will reflect the number of CME credits, credit hours, or contact hours you have earned. Remember to save the Certificate to your personal files as a record of your participation in the HTRS 2017 Scientific Symposium.



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Credits Offered

The HTRS 2017 Scientific Symposium has been planned and implemented in accordance with the accreditation requirements and policies of the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME) through the joint providership of The Postgraduate Institute for Medicine (PIM) and the Hemostasis and Thrombosis Research Society (HTRS).

The following types of continuing education credits are provided:

Continuing Medical Education for Physicians. PIM is accredited by the ACCME to provide continuing medical education for physicians. PIM designates this activity for a maximum of 14.5 *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits*[™]. Physicians should claim only the credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in this activity.

Continuing Nursing Education. PIM is accredited as a provider of continuing nursing education by the American Nurses Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation. This educational activity for 14.5 contact hours is provided by PIM.

Continuing Pharmacy Education. PIM is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education as a provider of continuing pharmacy education. PIM designates this continuing education activity for up to 14.5 contact hours (1.45 CEUs) of the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education.

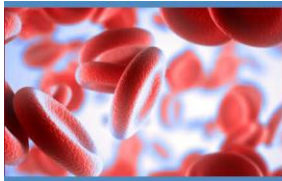
HTRS 2017 Welcome Reception and Dinner – Sponsored by Bioverativ

Transportation to and from the HTRS 2017 Awards Reception and Dinner

Transportation via coach buses will be provided from the DoubleTree Resort to the Ranch and back, but you may also arrange your own transportation. Remember to wear your lanyard/name badge if you are traveling via the coach buses, as you will need the event ticket attached to your name badge to board the bus.

Plan to board the buses at the lobby entrance of the DoubleTree Resort at least 10 minutes prior to departure, preferably by 6:30 p.m.

Travel time from the DoubleTree Resort to the Ranch is estimated to be 30-35 minutes one way. You may also choose to arrange your own transportation. Buses will depart from the DoubleTree promptly at 6:45 p.m. and will arrive at the Ranch by 7:30 p.m. for cocktails.

If you plan to drive independently to the Ranch, please stop by the Registration Desk before you leave to let us know, so we can release your seat on the bus.



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Dinner and the HTRS 2017 Awards Program will take place at the Ranch between 8:00 p.m. and 9:30 p.m., followed by live music and networking time.

Plan to board the buses to return to the DoubleTree Resort at 10:45 p.m.; buses will leave the Ranch no later than 11:00 p.m. and arrive back at the hotel by 11:35 p.m.

What to Wear

The Ranch features open air and covered dining/entertainment areas with ground cover consisting of fine gravel. We recommend casual attire comfortable for the weather and closed toe, low-heeled shoes. “Western” style wear is welcome but not required. Bring a jacket or sweater since evening temperatures in April can go as low as the 40s and 50s.

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Prepare for the Weather (and Indoor Temperatures)
